# Extra ELECTION

Due to the delay in the final arrangements for Brexit our school will now be used for the European elections on Thursday 23<sup>rd</sup> May. School will now close that day and the training day on Monday 24<sup>th</sup> June has been cancelled. This means that school will close for Spring Bank half term on Wednesday 22<sup>nd</sup> May at 3.20pm and reopen Monday 3<sup>rd</sup> June. Our Governors have already unsuccessfully appealed against school being used as a polling station due to the disruption it causes but will continue to do so on all our behalf.

# FREE SCHOOL MEALS

It is a time of real financial hardship for St Mary's. Difficult decisions are having to be made as to which resources, staffing levels and school building maintenance we can afford or not. You could help boost our budget simply by applying for free school meals EVEN IF your child already receives a school meal because they are in Reception, Yr 1 and Yr 2. For every successful application school receives an extra £1300-this money makes the difference on the number of classes we have in school, the number of books we can buy, the number of staff we can employ. This funding also helps to pay for the school nurse service and Graham (Catholic Care). Please take a few minutes to see if you would be eligible. If you are on a low income or in receipt of certain benefits then your child may be eligible. Please go to www.kirklees.gov.uk/schoolmeals or ring 01484 221928.

We have noticed there are at least 9 children (in EYU or classes 2/3 or 4/5) whose older siblings are registered but they are not, which means school could be getting at least another £10,000 into our budget-please check if you have registered all your children not just the older ones.

For all successful new applicants from 3<sup>rd</sup> May (today) a Tesco voucher will be available to be collected from the school office once we have received confirmation from the school finance office (Years Reception to Yr 6)
