TERM TIME ABSENCE AND HOLIDAYS

From September we have amended our procedures for requesting term time absence that have been approved by governors. This is due to school's overall attendance figure dropping once again.

- ANY absence taken in September will continue to be subject to a fixed penalty notice being issued of £60 per child per adult. Absence at the very beginning of the school year, especially in a school such as ours when classes have to be mixed up every year, can be catastrophic for a child's settling in period.
- All requests for a term time absence must be made via a holiday request form (available from the school office or downloadable from the school website from Tues 16th July)
- If a child's attendance is below 95% at the point of the absence, a fixed penalty notice will be issued, regardless of the circumstances.
