### School Meal Price Increase

#### From 5<sup>th</sup> September 2022

Please note that we have been informed by Kirklees Council Catering Service that the cost of a school dinner will be £2.40 per day/£12.00 per week from the 5<sup>th</sup> September.

If your child is currently in Year 2, from September school meals will be charged. Please ensure you credit your parentpay accounts to cover the costs of meals taken. If you don't have your account details, please contact the school office.

Milk for the Autumn term is now due. If you would like your child to have milk please pay the £11.65 through parent pay or at a pay point using the barcode provided. Closing date for payment is Monday 22<sup>nd</sup> August 2022.


